COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this beginner-intermediate Chinese as a second language course class is focus on having students master acquisition of the build up their vocabulary and repertoire of sentence patterns. Students are going to learn and practice basic-middle skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing also learn from Chinese cultural lessons ranging from Chinese idioms to the origins of various Chinese characters to typing Chinese on computers. The lessons build vocabulary and sentences upon each other in a spiral-up approach that helps students review and lays a strong language foundation. Most importantly, the lessons are student-centric to help prepare the learners for real-life communication.
