#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

The curriculum for kindergarten Social Studies aims to help children gain a broader understanding of themselves, and the things around them. We begin our learning journey by introducing topics that are closer to them, such as "Me" and "Family" in conjunction with picture story books and our SLOs and DIS's VISION MISSION which familiarizes children with the topics of Social Studies and encourages children to learn about the world around them. From the preschool Social Study class, children develop basic knowledge of history, geography, time and space. Children are engaged in group work and classroom discussion, which help them to practice their social skills and build a foundation of how society works. Moreover, to cultivate children's global view of other countries' traditions, such as clothing people around the world wear and different kinds of food people eat are included in the program.

#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

At the end of the course, students should be able to:

- 1. Express their feelings, such as happy, sad, and angry.
- 2. Identify different feelings, such as happy, sad, and angry.
- 3. Name the family members correctly in English, such as, father, mother, grandpa etc.
- 4. Describe things and/or buildings that they can see around their neighborhood.
- 5. Identify the country/ city / community they live in.
- 6. Explain how to be a good friend/helper in class.
- 7. Identify the flag of Taiwan, and the flag of their own country.
- 8. Identify appropriate behavior for school, such as no hitting, be friendly to each other etc.
- 9. Identify and describe different jobs that they can see in the community.
- 10. Explain how money works.

#### ASSESSMENT:

- Oral assessment:
  - After each lesson, students' ability to answer topic related questions will be count as part of the oral assessment.
  - At the end of each unit, the ability to point out and elaborate on the flash cards that represent the key vocabularies of the unit will be another oral assessment.
- Check list:
  - A checklist made according to the standards will *be use*d to assess children's understanding after each unit.
- Written Assessment:
  - At the end of each semester a written exam will be given.
- Observation:
  - A spontaneous in-class observation will be done by the teacher as a major identification of each child's understanding of the topic.
